

MPWGA – Special Event Tournaments Overview

General Guidelines only – Please check with each Special Event Chair for Specific Policies for Current Year. USGA-certified handicap required for all events

SADIE HAWKINS/BUBBA HAWKINS

- Normally occurs in February
- MPMGA and MPWGA host alternating years – Bubba hosted by MPMGA; Sadie hosted by MPWGA
- For Sadie, members ask any man (cannot be a spouse or significant other or last year's playing partner) to be their partner for the event
- May have 2-person teams or 4-person teams (decision by that year's Committee) with fun games/formats
- Awards Luncheon follows golf

PRESIDENT'S CUP

- Normally occurs in March
- Two-day **NET** tournament
- One day of golf at TP and one day of golf at MV
- Overall Champion is the player with the **best two-day low net total**
- Flighted with winners in each flight
- Scores are posted with a "T"; Handicap Chair or Weekly Events Committee posts all scores
- May offer an optional lunch on the first day; Awards Luncheon the second day
- Must have played six Tuesdays to be eligible

MEMBER/GUEST-- OLD PUEBLO CLASSIC

- Normally occurs in April
- Two-day event, normally followed by luncheon/dinner each day with award prizes on the second day
- One day of golf at TP and one day of golf at MV

- Format varies year-to-year; may be 2-women teams or 4-women teams (decision by that year's Committee)
- Guests cannot have MV or TP defined as their "home" course
- Entry fee includes luncheons and all prizes

HOME HOME & HOME

- Combined event with MPWGA, SBRWGA and SBWGA
- Play at MPWGA, SBRWGA and SBWGA on designated Tuesdays
- Players can play any or all days
- Lunch is included in entry fee and winners announced after each day's play

MEMBER/MEMBER --COYOTE CLASSIC

- Two-day event @ The Preserve and MountainView
- Two person team-- pick your MPWGA member partner
- Entry fee includes Awards Luncheon and all prizes

MARS & VENUS

- Normally occurs in September
- Teams consist of two MPWGA members and two MPMGA members
- Teams will be set up by the committee to allow the most competitive alignment of handicaps
- Days of play will be Tuesday & Thursday, which are normal play days for each association

CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP

- Normally occurs in November
- Two-day **GROSS** tournament
- One day of golf at TP and one day of golf at MV
- Overall Champion is the player with the **best two-day low gross total**
- Flighted with winners in each flight

- Scores are posted with a “T”; Handicap Chair or Weekly Events Committee posts all scores
- May offer an optional lunch on first day; Awards Luncheon the second day
- Must have played six Tuesdays to be eligible

CANCER FUNDRAISER

- Normally occurs in November
- May have silent auctions, raffles, or other forms of enhancing donations
- Members may donate directly to Cancer Charity at the event
- Luncheon and fundraising activities follow golf
