

MPWGA SDWGA Representative Job Description Reviewed: April 2021

**Position:** Southern District Women's Golf Association (SDWGA) Representative

**Purpose:** To offer women in the southern district of Arizona an opportunity to play at a variety of courses in the area.

## **Essential functions:**

- 1. Collect \$10 per local SDWGA member through MPWGA membership annual dues. MPWGA members have the option to join SDWGA each year.
- 2. Send \$5 per member with completed forms (obtained from SDWGA) to SDWGA. The other \$5 per member will be held in the MPWGA Treasury for prizes in the two local (MV/P) tournaments.
- 3. Keep local (MPWGA/SDWGA) members apprised of upcoming SDWGA tournaments. Three two person tournaments are played at rotating courses each year in the southern Arizona district.
- 4. Maintain list of MPWGA members who join SDWGA. Yearly list will be created by the MPWGA Membership Chair.
- 5. Work with the MPWGA Weekly Events Chair to run the two local SDWGA tournaments played on MPWGA league days.

Del Sud Tournament: Two day Ringer event, to be held on two league play days. Must be held at the same course and Handicap from Day 1 is used for both days. Final score equals the total of the best score from each hole from each of the two days. Day 1 handicap is subtracted. Field is flighted, and at least 30% of the field is paid.

Telegraph Tournament: One day tournament—Best Net Total Score. Flighted, and at least 30% of field is paid. Distribute monetary prizes to winners of these tournaments.
